Lighting industry leader on climate policy to address Sydney seminar

A leading figure in the lighting industry, who has been the architect of lighting and climate change strategy, will address a seminar in Sydney on Tuesday.

A range of speakers will join Mr Harry Verhaar, Head of Global Public and Government Affairs for Signify, who is based in Europe.

Mr Verhaar is an active member of a number of partnerships and networks including The Climate Group, Regions 20, the World Green Building Council and the UN Environment Science Business Policy Forum.

Signify (Phillips) is Australia's largest lighting company and Mr Verhaar is responsible for the company's engagement with the UN and is a founding member of the UN Environment's enlighten program and the SE4A11's Global Energy Efficient Accelerator Program.

The seminar, organised by Lighting Council Australia will examine recycling of lighting and e-waste and the current landscape of product stewardship in Australia.
