WESTERN AUSTRALIAN BUSINESSES SCOOP LIGHTING INDUSTRY AWARDS

At the Lighting Council Australia's National Awards for Excellence in Lighting, a number of leading Western Australian businesses have been recognised.

Marie Botsis-Premici, owner of The Montauk Lighting Co. in Perth was the joint winner of the Overall Innovation Award. Montauk has a reputation for producing high-quality decorative lighting, landing national recognition through this event. 300 guests attended the awards night held at the Four Seasons Hotel in Sydney on Tuesday night (October 24).

The other joint winner in the innovation category was Michael Jarvis, owner of MOMA Solar in Perth. MOMA Solar has built a reputation for producing innovative lighting in the solar space, especially for the mining industry.

Another Western Australian lighting company, LEDTEC, whose owner is Serg Radic, was recognized for his outstanding engagement with industry - one of the most sought-after awards in the lighting industry.

Serg's nomination was supported by a range of industry colleagues including key suppliers in the Perth market.

He was the joint winner of this award along with Tristan Downs (originally from Western Australia) who owns Melbourne-based company HIGHLUX. Tristan Downs has been a driving force in the development of solar lighting policy for the lighting industry.
